ARTIST BIOGRAPHY – JP BELL

JP Bell is a Filipino-born contemporary artist, poet, and street photographer based in Timaru, New Zealand whose works have been exhibited across the Philippines, New Zealand, Canada, Iceland and Cyprus.

Recognised in 2012 as The Empowered Poet and Artist of the Year by World Poetry International at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, Canada, his practice explores mortality and transformation through abstract art and urban neo-expressionist form.

In 2013, he received the “Inspirational Poet 2013” award at the National Museum of the Philippines, presented during the World Friendship Poetry Celebration organised by the National Library of the Philippines, Pentasi B Poetry, and the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (Philippines).

Bell's street photography has been published in Vogue Italia and other international publications, reflecting the breadth of his interdisciplinary practice.

Bell is scheduled to present a major solo exhibition at the Aigantighe Art Gallery, Timaru, from December 2028 to February 2029, with his work already held in private collections across Germany, Australia, New Zealand and the Philippines.

Central to Bell's work is Ōamaru Stone, a limestone formed some 34 million years ago beneath New Zealand's ancient seas. By embedding it directly into his paintings, Bell fuses a fragment of the country's deep geological history into each canvas, creating works at the intersection of contemporary art, archaeology, and cultural memory.
